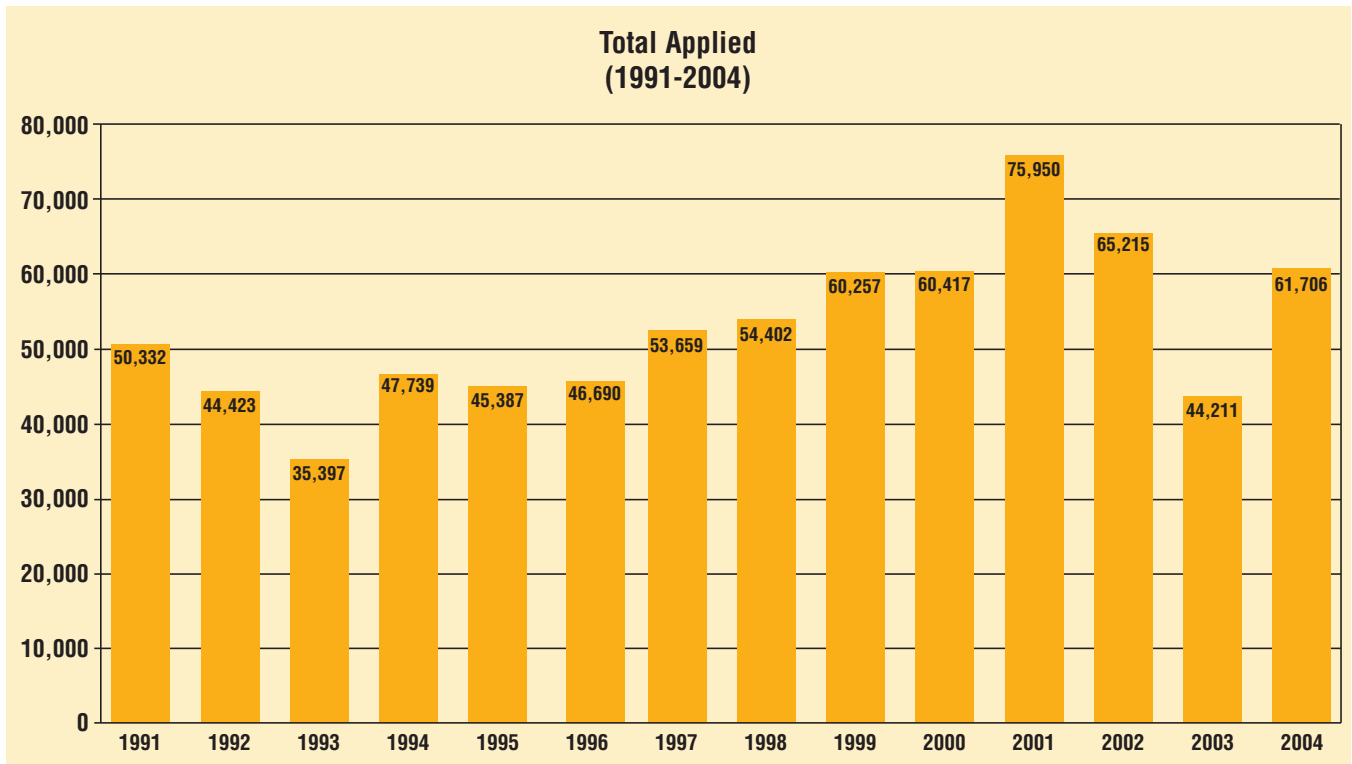


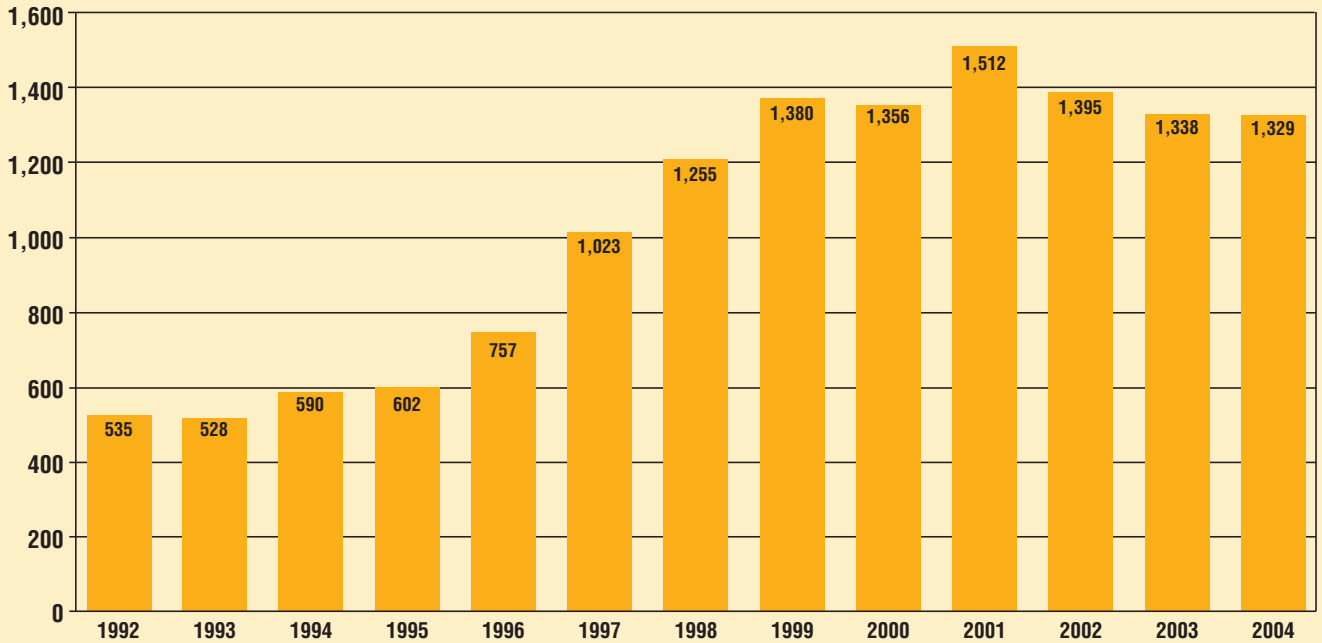
Recent History: Applications For Electrical Apprenticeships

Apprentices must pass an algebra test and a drug test in order to be considered. Of those who applied in 2004, almost 22,500 were interviewed.

Apprentices Dropped (1992-2004)



Apprentices are “indentured” into local NECA-IBEW training programs. This includes the signing of an agreement which commits the NECA-IBEW team to provide the apprentice with on-the-job and classroom training and much more. There is also a commitment by the apprentice as well.

Those who are unwilling or unable to sustain a good effort are dropped; depending on circumstances, some are allowed to repeat a given year.
